RULES & REGULATIONS

Win = 3 points

All games must result in a win.

In Round Robin Games, if a game is tied after regulation time, there will be an immediate Penalty Kick Shoot-out.

(3 shots per team, alternating teams). If still tied then the penalty kick shoot-out will continue with alternating shots per team until a winner is decided. Each kicker must be different, and cannot kick again until everyone on the team has taken a kick, including goalkeepers (if the shoot-out goes on that long).

In Final Games, if there is a tie after regulation time, then there will be one 7 minute golden goal overtime played. If still tied then there will be a Penalty kick shoot-out. (5 shots per team, alternating teams). If still tied then the penalty kick shoot-out will continue with alternating shots per team until a winner is decided. Each kicker must be different, and cannot kick again until everyone on the team has taken a kick, including goalkeepers (if the shoot-out goes on that long).

GROUP STANDINGS

Standings in the Groups after the Round Robin Games will be determined first by total points earned. If two teams are tied the winner will be decided by how they did in head to head competition in the round robin. If three or more teams are tied in points then the team with the best goal difference (total goals for minus total goals against) will be the winner. If there is still a tie there will be a coin toss to determine the winner.

- Shin Pads are mandatory!
- Outdoor soccer shoes are allowed on the field turf. Indoor soccer shoes also work well.
- No outdoor footwear allowed on the playing surface. Please remove them before entering the fields.
- Only water is permitted on the fields. No gum, no food or drinks. No Spitting!

GAME RULES

Regular BCISL indoor soccer rules will apply.

6 a-side (5 plus a goalie).

1. Goalies can throw the ball overhand this year, as well as drop kick, etc. as last year.
2. Goal kicks can be taken from anywhere inside the goal crease.
3. Penalty kicks are to be taken from the spot marked above the centre of the goal crease line. All other players must be at least three meters farther back from the penalty spot.
4. Balls played out over the sidelines will be a kick-in from the line, with the ball placed behind the line from where it was played out. Kick-ins are indirect free kicks.
5. For indirect fouls inside the penalty area, the ball is brought out to the goal crease line nearest to where the infraction occurred.
6. On all free kicks opponents must be at least 5 meters from the ball.
7. On the fly substitution are allowed. However, players must come off at their own bench only, and must be within a meter or so of their bench before the new player can come on to the field of play. A yellow card will be shown to the oncoming player for any infractions of this rule.
8. Sliding **tackles** are NOT ALLOWED!

DISCIPLINARY RULES

YELLOW CARDS

Yellow cards will carry over from one game to the next. Any player who receives 3 yellow cards during the course of the tournament will be suspended for 1 game, the game immediately following their last booking.

RED CARDS

A red card is an automatic 1 game suspension. Further disciplinary action, such as increased suspensions, may be taken by the disciplinary committee depending upon the severity of the violation.

Any form of violent conduct may result in expulsion from the tournament, either for individual players or the entire team!

Fighting will not be tolerated!

A reminder to all BCISL players. Suspensions and disciplinary action for violations during this tournament may also be carried over to league play

APPEALS

Appeals regarding suspensions or any other tournament ruling must be made in writing, and be accompanied by a \$25 appeals fee, to any member of the tournament committee (only if the appeal is successful will the appeals fee be returned).

All appeals must be made within 30 minutes following the game in question, otherwise it will not be accepted.

Appeals disputing a referee's interpretation of the laws of the game will not be heard. The referee's decision in all matches shall be final.
